Cattlemen's Days Market Place Rules June 2017

Exhibitors must meet the following requirements to be eligible to participate in the project Market Place:

Enrolled members, ages 8-18 as of January 1 of current enrollment year. Enrolled in the project that they are selling their exhibit or items or services related

to project.

Sellers must do the following in order to participate in the Market Place.

Submit a fair entry on or before the deadline.

Include a completed record book along with project exhibit.

Participate in the interview with the judge.

Be present at your table. Someone else cannot do the selling.

Work the set-up of the Judging, Project Revue, or Exhibits.

Market Place will be open at 6:45 pm on night of the Project Revue and close an hour after the Revue is over.

Each seller will share a 7 foot table. They have use of that space to set up displays, items for sale, information about their project, etc.

Sellers may sell items or services they choose; they must be related or connected to their project(s). Participants may sell their non-edible exhibits. Participants with edible or perishable exhibits may sell a duplicate of their exhibit and/or other items or services related to their project and project unit. There are no limits on the number and price of items. Both is at the discretion of the seller.

Sellers can barter and or take bids during the Market.

Sellers will be responsible for collecting money or using the General Project Committee Market Program if buyers need for tax contribution purposes.

Sellers will be responsible for delivering their items or services if they are selling their non-edible exhibit. You will need to make arrangements if you are selling a State Fair eligible item.
